Dr. Kimihiko Oishi is Assistant Professor of Department of Genetics and Genomic Sciences and Department of Pediatrics at Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai in New York. He received his medical degree from Jikei University School of Medicine in Tokyo in 1994, followed by pediatrics residency at Jikei University Hospital. After his research fellowship in a molecular cardiology laboratory at Mount Sinai, he completed his pediatrics residency and medical genetics fellowship at Mount Sinai Hospital. Since he joined the faculty at Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai in 2014, Dr. Oishi has been working as an attending physician at the Program for Inherited Metabolic Diseases Clinic with a special interest in the mechanism of disease and development of new therapies for inborn errors of metabolism. He is a recipient of awards including Eastern Society for Pediatric Research Young Investigator Award and The Society for Pediatric Research Fellow's Basic Research Award.
